

Apprenticeship in Supply Chain Management

Overview

This qualification will enable learners to:

- gain knowledge and practical skills within supply chain operations
- contribute to the supply chain activities of their organisation
- gain a recognized qualification which shows employers that they have the knowledge, skills and understanding to carry out their role to a professional standard

This qualification offers many progression opportunities for the learner – from apprenticeships to wider employment.

Level 3 Diploma in Supply Chain Management

This qualification has a minimum of 218 guided learning hours (GLH) and 42 credits. It has a total qualification time of 420 hours which is the notional time required by the learner to complete the qualification.

This qualification can be obtained by completing the two mandatory assessment routes, and choosing from a selection of optional assessment routes to make up the remaining 37 credits.
